

## Momento's in The Ark of the Covenant

Students of the Scriptures know that the Ark of the Covenant contained these things which God had Moses and Aaron place within it.

- × The Ten Commandments written on stone – **Exodus 25:21, Deuteronomy 10:25**
- × The Rod of Aaron that budded – **Numbers 17**
- × A Pot of Manna – **Exodus 16:31-35**

The Mercy Seat (**Exodus 25:1**), as well as the two Cherubims (**Exodus 25:22**) from which God spoke, covered it. It was covered by a veil and was in the Most Holy Place.



However, 500 years later, only the two tables were in it. **I Kings 8:9**

The Ark is now lost to man and has no significance to us. Today, Jesus is our Ark.

The Law on the stones is fulfilled in Christ. The

Priesthood is no longer Aaron's, but Jesus'. He is our manna from Heaven.

**THE TABLES OF TESTIMONY**, or the Law, pronounces us dead in trespasses and sins. But Jesus fulfilled the Law and we are made righteous and alive in Him.

Christ, our **MANNA**, gives us life, for He is the Bread of Life. The omer was one day's bread, and they gathered no more and no less. We need no more nor no less than Christ for Spiritual sustenance.

The **ROD OF AARON** showed Aaron as the High Priest. It bore blossoms (for beauty), buds (a sign of life), and almonds, (fruit bearing). His rod showed that Aaron had authority or power to mediate.

But the Ark, the Ten Commandments, the Manna, Aaron's Rod, nor even the Temple exists today.

Here is what God says of the Ark: "And it shall come to pass, when ye be multiplied and increased in the land, in those days, saith the LORD, they shall say no more, **The ark of the covenant of the LORD: neither shall it come to mind: neither shall they remember it; neither shall they visit it; neither shall that be done any more.**" **Jeremiah 3:16** These things are all done away in Christ.

These items were a figure or type:

1. **Jesus fulfilled the Law and we are made righteous in Christ.**
2. **Jesus is the Bread of Life and is all-sufficient for our needs.**
3. **Jesus is our High Priest and He causes us to blossom to new life and bear the fruit of righteousness.**
4. **Jesus is the Cornerstone of a new temple, which temple we are.**

The Ark and its contents and its location have no more significance to us today than the brazen serpent. They were only temporal manifestations or typical objects fulfilled in Christ to show the privileges and blessings of grace we have in Christ.

Who cares where the Ark is? The Babylonians may have taken it. It may have been hidden under the temple mount. It may be that Ethiopia has it, as some claim.

I know Indiana Jones did not find the Ark of the Covenant.

However, you can find its privileges and blessings when you come to Christ. All these blessings are in Christ, Jesus, our Ark.

The Roman Church claims that Mary is the Ark of the Covenant for she bore Him. This is a blasphemous teaching.

Jesus is the Ark of the Covenant, for it is through Him we hear God's voice and find a mercy seat and the forgiveness of our sins.

He is our life and our risen High Priest who makes us righteous without the Law.

Praise Him for who He is!!!

(Notice the very first NEW commandment....)

2 - Guide reproduction wisely, improving fitness and diversity.

3 - Unite humanity with a living new language.

4 - Rule passion, faith, tradition, and all things with tempered reason.

5 - Protect people and nations with fair laws and just courts. (How are they going to get rid of 6.7 billion in a "just way"?)

6 - Let all nations rule internally resolving external disputes in a **world court**.

7 - Avoid petty laws and useless officials. Balance personal rights with social duties. (As determined by whom?)

8 - Prize truth, beauty, love, seeking harmony with the infinite. (How can you prize truth and rule faith?)

9 - Be not a cancer on the earth. Leave room for nature. Leave room for nature. (This is not a duplication error, it's written this way but does this mean let animals dominate us?)

10 - Balance personal rights with social duties. (How? "Without petty laws and useless officials"?)

Why hasn't anyone passed this information along? It's been 33 years since they were erected in 1980, by some anonymous man named, R. C. Christian!

Now if I lived in that area and saw them, I would inquire why they were there, who decided THESE were to be our NEW laws? Who made this anonymous group the ones to obey these new "secretly placed" laws? These actually go against our very own constitution.

### These are Done Right Under Our Nose

This is nothing new under the sun. Even history shows how evil works have been done right under people's noses....

Let's review some Scriptures, then look at the lessons we should learn from them:

#### Moses

Moses had gone up to Mount Sinai to obtain the tables of the REAL Ten Commandments, yet the people saw his delay in coming down and totally forgot all that God had done in bringing them out of Egypt. (How quickly people forget God's work in our lives!!) **Exodus 32:1-8**

So they got up and began to play and wanted to have a "god" to worship.....And while Moses was fasting, working his way up the mountain, meeting with the Lord, and receiving specific instructions from God, Himself.....the people were having a party and sinning in various ways. **Right under his nose.**

**Lesson** – People abuse new freedom and fall into rebellion.

#### Solomon

**I Kings 11:4**, "For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, that his wives turned away his heart after other gods: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as was the heart of David his father."

Solomon was the wisest man in the world yet he continued to marry numerous wives. Many of these wives were foreigners and apart from their husbands' daily life.

He had groves built for several of his wives' foreign gods, probably to appease them since he was not with them and they could not be with any other man. When he was older, Solomon worshipped at the gods of his wives.

So when the wisest man in the world does these things, a son of David who was loved so by God, the people would certainly feel they could follow in the same manner. God had to bring punishment sooner or later.

**Solomon's sin was done right under their nose.**

**Lesson** – Rulers who think they are wise and think one God is as good as another cause God's people to sin and they follow like sheep. (The Lord is NOT Allah).

#### Haman

**Esther 5:12-14**, "12 Haman said moreover, Yea, Esther the queen did let no man come in with the king unto the

banquet that she had prepared but myself; and to morrow am I invited unto her also with the king. 13 Yet all this availeth me nothing, so long as I see Mordecai the Jew sitting at the king's gate. 14 Then said Zeresh his wife and all his friends unto him, Let a gallows be made of fifty cubits high, and to morrow speak thou unto the king that Mordecai may be hanged thereon: then go thou in merrily with the king unto the banquet. And the thing pleased Haman; and he caused the gallows to be made."

The king didn't even know what Haman was planning by trying to decree in the king's name to exterminate the Jewish race. He planned, schemed, and even paid the King a vast amount of money to aid his evil plan. His family and friends urged him to build a gallows to hang Mordecai, the one who opposed him and caused this anger to build against these people. **All was done right under the King's nose.**

**Lesson** - Leaders pass earth-shaking laws they plan to read after the law has been passed. (Shades of Pelosi)

#### Look Around

– And understand the warnings that we are being given. We must continue to teach, take a stand for what is Godly, and not compromise our morals just because the world will do wrong.

#### Look Down

– Into the Word of God to make sure we are doing our part to understand His Will in our lives and pass that along to others.

#### Look Up

– To God as our guide and authority. His Word will keep our focus on Him.

Let's pray for our Nation, for God's people, and those in our leadership who are doing wrong, that there may be repentance.

  - b. Mother – Elizabeth – “The Lord’s Oath”

- a. Not useless penance of a pagan church.

  - **Populace**...Share your food, clothes. If you are not made generous...a sharer, you have not repented.

Change of mind, lifestyle, value system.

Not vain, "Hail Mary"...repetition. It was practical.

- **Publicans**...be honest, don't overcharge or use your job for covetousness.
- **Police**...don't intimidate (shake), or take bribes but be content.

Repentance has to do with my stewardship, possessions, how much I charge, how content I am.

- Repentance puts things in perspective.
  - \* Gets you to share, be honest, not intimidate.
- Repentance is the stewardship of things.
  - \* Be sharing what I have got.
  - \* Be honest in the way that I get it.
  - \* Be content with what I'm getting.
- Sensitive about other people's needs.
  - \* Who is in need, abused, exploited?
  - \* Not abuse, but help.

\* Not intimidate, but protect.

\* Not exploit...or overcharge...but look at needs.

- Repentance - It is not conformity to John's dress, diet, or hermit life.
- Checkbook may have more to do with Heaven and Hell than your Hymnbook.
- Live in this world:
  - \* Justly
  - \* Fairly
  - \* Compassionately
  - \* Generously
  - \* Contently
- It changes my attitude toward my wealth, my possessions, those in need. **Luke 19:8**

### 16. A Unique Humility

How John saw himself.

- a. **Matthew 3:13-17**, "13 Then cometh Jesus from Galilee to Jordan unto John, to be baptized of him. 14 **But John forbad him, saying, I have need to be baptized of thee, and comest thou to me?** 15 And Jesus answering said unto him, Suffer *it to be so* now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. Then he suffered him. 16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him: 17 And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."
- b. **Mark 1:7**, And preached, saying, **There cometh one mightier than I after me, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to stoop down and unloose."**
- c. **John 3:25-36**, "25 Then there arose a question between *some* of John's disciples and the Jews about purifying. 26 And they came unto John, and said unto him, Rabbi, he that was with thee beyond Jordan, to whom thou barest witness, behold, the same baptizeth, and all *men* come to him. 27 John answered and said, **A man can receive nothing, except it be given him from heaven. 28 Ye yourselves bear me witness, that I said, I am not the Christ, but that I am sent before him. 29 He that hath the bride is the bridegroom: but the friend of the bridegroom, which standeth and heareth him, rejoiceth greatly because of the bridegroom's voice: this my joy therefore is fulfilled. 30 He must increase, but I must decrease. 31 He that cometh from above is above all:** he that is of the earth is earthly, and speaketh of the earth: he that cometh from heaven is above all. 32 And what he hath seen and heard, that he testifieth; and no man receiveth his testimony. 33 He that hath received his testimony hath set to his seal that God is true. 34 **For he whom God hath sent**

**speakeeth the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him.** 35 The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into his hand. 36 He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him."

- d. **Luke 3:15-18**, "15 And as the people were in expectation, and all men mused in their hearts of John, whether he were the Christ, or not; 16 John answered, saying unto *them* all, **I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire: 17 Whose fan is in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and will gather the wheat into his garner; but the chaff he will burn with fire unquenchable.** 18 And many other things in his exhortation preached he unto the people."
- e. **John 1:15-27**, 15 John bare witness of him, and cried, saying, **This was he of whom I spake, He that cometh after me is preferred before me: for he was before me. 16 And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.** 17 For the law was given by Moses, *but* grace and truth came by Jesus Christ. 18 No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared *him*. 19 And this is the record of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou? 20 **And he confessed, and denied not; but confessed, I am not the Christ.** 21 **And they asked him, What then? Art thou Elias?** And he saith, I am not. Art thou that prophet? And he answered, No. 22 Then said they unto him, Who art thou? that we may give an answer to them that sent us. What sayest thou of thyself? 23 He said, **I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, as said the prophet Esaias.** 24 **And they which were sent were of the Pharisees.** 25 And they asked him, and said unto him, Why baptizest thou then, if thou be not that Christ, nor Elias, neither that prophet? 26 John answered them, saying, **I baptize with water: but there standeth one among you, whom ye know not; 27 He it is, who coming after me is preferred before me, whose shoe's latchet I am not worthy to unloose."**
